

## ***ASHP Accredited Pharmacy Practice Residency***

### **University at Buffalo & Bassett Healthcare**

#### **Residency Site**

The primary practice site for the residency is at Bassett Healthcare in Cooperstown, NY. Bassett Healthcare is a community teaching hospital and referral center situated in Cooperstown on the northern fringe of the Catskills in Central New York State. It is devoted to optimal patient care in the context of teaching and research. A generous endowment and a full-time, salaried professional staff make this possible. The Hospital is formally affiliated with Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons, with many of the attending physicians having faculty appointments. The Carnegie Commission cited Bassett Healthcare as the ideal prototype for the provision of high quality medical care in a rural setting.

#### **Learning Experiences**

The Pharmacy Practice Residency Program has been in continuous existence since 1978. The primary goal of the Bassett Healthcare pharmacy practice residency program is to train and develop residents who possess in-depth knowledge and skills in clinical pharmacy practice. The primary emphasis of the pharmacy practice residency is the development of a wide spectrum of practice skills in medicine, surgery, ambulatory care, drug information, pharmacokinetics and clinical pharmacology.

Secondary goals of the program are to develop knowledge and skills in comprehensive pharmacy practice, teaching, and research methodology. Comprehensive pharmacy practice knowledge and skills refer to pharmacy administration, professional practice, and current issues. Teaching opportunities include leading clinical clerkships and facilitating small group discussions. Research opportunities in conjunction with the clinical faculty are extensive. The resident's involvement in both teaching and research is mandatory.

#### **Application**

Applicants must have a Doctor of Pharmacy degree. NYS licensure is not a requirement. This residency is ASHP accredited and as such, we participate in the ASHP Matching Program. Application deadline is January 31, of each year. For further information, please contact:
