PHARMD REQUIRED COURSES



The doctor of pharmacy curriculum at the UB SPPS is designed to prepare students to serve as contemporary, compassionate, creative, and scholarly pharmacy practitioners, educators, researchers, and leaders in the advancement of the pharmacy profession. It provides the educational foundation for an entry-level pharmacy practitioner. The curriculum consists of courses in basic biomedical sciences, clinical sciences, pharmaceutical sciences, and pharmacy practice. The coursework is integrated with progressive patient-centered practice experiences with a focus centered on educating entry-level practitioners capable of providing care. This program in pharmacy leads to licensure in any state provided that the graduate passes and obtains licensure in the state requested. Students are required to complete **eight elective credit hours** – these can be completed at any time during the P1-P3 years.
