The vision of the Department of Pharmacy is to be the best in pharmacy practice for our patients, caregivers, and community.

Cleveland Clinic Health System

Students have the opportunity to complete rotations at any of the hospitals in the health system, ambulatory pharmacies, and patient care clinics. Our Ambulatory Pharmacies are owned by Cleveland Clinic, and they provide dispensing services, medication therapy management (MTM), and bedside delivery. Patients are seen daily in Patient Care Clinics for multiple services, including anticoagulation and diabetes management. Our Patient Care Clinics are located on hospital sites and in Family Health Centers throughout the community.

Akron General

- › 532-bed tertiary care, academic medical center
- › **Specialty services in:** cardiology, endocrinology, gastroenterology, geriatrics, hematology and oncology, level I trauma care, maternity care, nephrology, orthopedics, pain management, and pulmonology

Avon Hospital

- › 126-private bed hospital
- › **Specialty services in:** cardiology, emergency medicine, endocrinology, gastroenterology, general medicine, general surgery, gynecology, infectious disease, nephrology, ophthalmology, orthopedics, palliative care, pulmonology, and urology

Euclid Hospital

- › 166-bed acute-care facility with a 40-bed skilled nursing unit
- › **Specialty services in:** chronic care, congestive heart failure, emergency medicine, occupational and speech therapy, orthopedics, physical rehabilitation, primary care, and senior behavioral health

Fairview Hospital

- › 488-bed acute care community teaching hospital
- › **Specialty services in:** comprehensive cardiovascular care, comprehensive obstetric care, hematology and oncology, level II trauma care, level III neonatology care, nephrology, neurology, pain management, pediatrics, stroke care, surgery, and urology

Hillcrest Hospital

- › Full-service, 496-bed hospital
- › **Specialty services in:** comprehensive cardiovascular care, digestive health, hematology and oncology, level III neonatology care, level II trauma care, maternity care, pain management, and surgery

Lutheran Hospital

- › 204-bed acute care facility
- › **Specialty services in:** behavioral health, emergency medicine, orthopedics, pain management, physical and occupational therapy, primary care, sports medicine, substance use disorders, urology, and wound healing

Main Campus

- › 1400-bed academic medical center
- › **Specialty services in:** dermatology and plastic surgery, digestive disease, emergency medicine, endocrinology and metabolism, genomic medicine, head and neck, heart and vascular medicine, hematology and oncology, neurology, ophthalmology, orthopedics, pediatrics, respiratory medicine, rheumatology, and urology

Marymount Hospital

- › **Specialty services in:** cardiovascular care, emergency medicine, general surgery, hematology and oncology, obstetrics, occupational and speech therapy, orthopedics, pain management, physical rehabilitation, rheumatology, stroke, urology, vascular medicine, and wound care

South Pointe Hospital

- › 173-bed acute care community, osteopathic teaching hospital
- › **Specialty services in:** cardiology, emergency medicine, gastroenterology, hematology and oncology, orthopedics, primary care, stroke care, and vascular medicine

Union Hospital

- › 149-bed hospital which also has off-campus satellites
- › **Specialty services in:** behavioral health, cardiology, emergency medicine, hematology and oncology, maternity care, pain management, primary care, pulmonary rehabilitation, rehabilitation and sports medicine, stroke care, surgery, vascular medicine, and wound healing

Miscellaneous Information

Housing is not provided by Cleveland Clinic, but the Student Housing Program can provide assistance for housing arrangements. Parking is assigned on the first day of rotation at no charge for all Cleveland Clinic locations. Students will have the opportunity to attend multiple education conferences and will have access to electronic medical records, multiple drug information references, and the medical library. Each hospital has a full-service cafeteria.

If you'll be visiting Cleveland Clinic for less than a year, please let us help arrange your short-term housing. We've vetted several housing options and negotiated a student rate for each.

Most of the housing options are fully furnished, and many are within a short car or public transportation ride to the Cleveland Clinic main campus. Some have en suite washers, dryers, fitness centers, and free use of computers and printers.

The prices vary depending on the unit size and location, availability, and your willingness to share common living spaces and bathrooms. Some establishments may charge an additional fee for utilities and certain amenities, such as Wi-Fi, garage parking, and linens.
