#### ★ VA Western New York Healthcare System is a tertiary medical center serving >80,000 Veterans

- Buffalo Campus
  - Medicine, Surgery, Critical Care, ED, Primary Care and various specialties
- Batavia Campus
  - CLC & Primary Care
- Community Based Outpatient Clinics (CBOCs)
  - Niagara Falls, Lockport, West Seneca, Springville, Dunkirk, Jamestown and Olean

### VA Western New York

#### ★ VAWNY has services at the Buffalo site

- Similar to any tertiary medical center
  - Medicine (Hospitalists)
  - Critical Care (Intensivists)
  - Surgery (most except neurosurgery)
  - Behavioral Health
  - Specialists (Dermatology, Rheumatology, Cardiology, Infectious Diseases, Hem/Onc, Podiatry etc)
  - Community Living Centers (CLCs) aka LTC

- VAWNY Community Living Centers Pharmacy services at Buffalo and Batavia include:

  - Interdisciplinary Meetings
  - Team Rounding
  - Consults
  - Formulary Management

 VAWNY has outpatient pharmacy services at both the Buffalo and Batavia sites

- Similar to community pharmacy
  - Rxs for pick up at the medical center pharmacy
  - Rxs mailed to patients
  - No money exchange at the pharmacy itself
- Utilize a mail-out program called "CMOP" which processes >50% of our Rxs

- VAWNY Ambulatory Pharmacy services at Buffalo and Batavia include:
  - Primary Care Service (DM, HTN etc)
    - General population (PACT)
    - Women's (WWC)
    - Geriatrics (HBPC)
    - Community Clinics (CBOCs)
  - Anticoagulation Management (Warfarin, DOACs etc)
  - Mental Health (PTSD, SUD, Metabolic etc)
  - Geriatrics
  - HCV
  - Consults
  - Formulary Management
