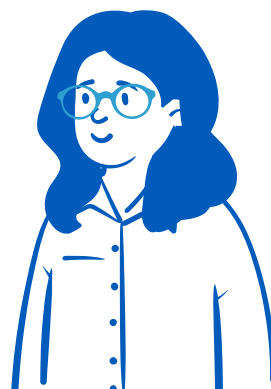


EndNote
